



The “**Career Breakfast**” is an opportunity for Schools, South West VETlink and established P&F and or Parent bodies to work collaboratively and build on the relationships between parents, industry and students as career partners.

This project aims to assist the parents, to coordinate a professional mentoring opportunity that encourages an informed transition from the school environment into the workplace or career choice of the Student.

Together with a South West VETlink project coordinator and school representative, parents will be encouraged to share their extensive industry and professional contacts to create a unique opportunity for their Senior School Students.

**Outcomes:** Students and their chosen Career Professional will:

1. Sit together within a group (max of 6) and enjoy an informal breakfast
2. Discuss career opportunities, traditional pathways and current opportunities
3. Acknowledge parents and the school environment as a valuable resource in Career Development

Note:

- It is recognised by South West VETlink that individual schools and their parent body will have different needs when coordinating and implementing their Career Breakfast, therefore a flexible format will apply.
- South West VETlink will contribute towards breakfast costs for each school.
- South West VETlink Co-ordinators will facilitate parent groups to achieve outcomes.
- Schools will be required to provide a coordinator to assist with specific student details.
