CHANGES FOR SCHOOL-BASED AND PART-TIME APPRENTICESHIPS

The Western Australian Industrial Relations Commission (WAIRC) has handed down a General Order to provide minimum wages and conditions for school-based and part-time apprentices covered by State awards, agreements and the Minimum Conditions of Employment Act 1993.

Flexible training options have been created to encourage the take up of apprenticeships.

The General Order provides model clauses which outline the minimum hourly rate of pay and conditions for school-based and part-time apprenticeships. The model clauses are to be read in conjunction with the relevant industrial instrument. The General Order is effective on the first pay period on or after 18 April 2007.
